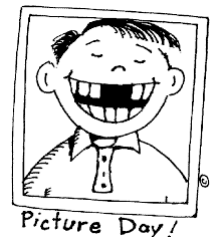

Here's a quick look at what your child has been learning in some of the subjects so far...

Language Arts

We've kicked off an exciting author study featuring the talented Chris Van Dusen! Each week, we'll dive into one of his great stories and follow up with an activity that connects to the book. The students are loving the humour and vivid illustrations! On top of that, we've begun our handwriting journey—with eager hands and growing confidence!

Math

This month, we are focusing on four key math skills as part of the Grade 3 Provincial Assessment. These activities will help us understand each student's confidence and competence in math entering Grade 3. All results will be shared with you during our Parent/Teacher conferences in early November. After the assessment period, we'll launch into a fun and hands-on unit on geometry!

Bible

In Bible class, we're exploring the story of David's anointing in 1 Samuel 16. The students are learning how God chose David—not for how he looked, but for his heart. It's a powerful reminder that God sees beyond the surface and has a purpose for each of us!

Social Studies

We've started the year with a unit called *Connecting with Canadians*. In this unit, students are discovering what it means to be active, responsible members of their communities. We're learning about rights, responsibilities, and what it means to care for others—both near and far!
